



## United Federation of Volunteer for Refugees Action Calling terms and conditions

As a registered united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia Calling fundraiser, you must adhere to the following terms and conditions. Failure to conduct third party fundraising activities in accordance with these terms and conditions may result in you being de-registered as a united federation of volunteers for refugees action Australia Calling fundraiser and prevented from conducting further third-party fundraising activities on behalf of United federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia;

### Definitions:

“**We/** united federation of volunteers for refugees action Australia / united federation of volunteers for refugees action Australia /**Promoter**” means united federation of volunteers for refugees action Australia ABN 70 678 268 916. “United federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia” means a united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia national fundraising campaign of that name.

“**Event**” includes a united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia Calling fundraising activity.

“**Event Websites/Websites**” means the online information portal for united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia Calling at <http://www.ufvra.org.au/>

“**You**” means the person who registers to conduct a fundraising event for united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia Calling.

“**Fundraiser/Fundraising**” means the act of holding an event with the intention of raising funds for united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia.

**“Collector/Collection”** means the person who registers to conduct door to door or public coin collections on behalf of united federation of volunteers for refugee’s action Australia for united federation of volunteers for refugee’s action Australia Calling.

**“Register/Registering/Registered”** means completing the united federation of volunteers for refugee’s action Australia Calling registration form either on paper and returning it by mail or email or by registering as a Host over the telephone or online at <http://www.ufvra.org.au/>

**“Registered Fundraiser”** means a person who has completed in full the united federation of volunteers for refugee’s action Australia Calling registration form, and returned it to united federation of volunteers for refugee’s action Australia by post or email or who has completed the registration form online at <http://www.ufvra.org.au/> or <http://www.ufvra.org.au/> or who has provided their details to a united federation of volunteers for refugee’s action Australia representative over the telephone.

“United federation of volunteers for refugee’s action Australia **Calling Month**” means Thursday, 4<sup>th</sup> March 2018 to Saturday, 31<sup>st</sup> March 2018.

**“Fundraiser Welcome Kit”** means the promotional material provided to a Registered Fundraiser to use in planning and running their fundraising event or activity for united federation of volunteers for refugee’s action Australia.

**“Supporter”** means a person who agrees to help a Registered Fundraiser with their event, either financially or in-kind.

**“Promotional Period”** means Monday, 24<sup>nd</sup> January 2019 to Sunday, 29<sup>th</sup> April 2018.

**“Advertisers”** means third party operated websites.

**“Linked Sites”** means third party operated hyperlinks.

**“Incentive Prizes”** means prizes awarded to a Registered Host.

**“Highest Individual Fundraisers”** means the Registered Individual Hosts who raise the most amount of money through their united federation of volunteers for refugee’s action Australia calling fundraising.

**“Highest Group Fundraisers”** means the Registered Groups who raise the most amount of money through their united federation of volunteers for refugee’s action Australia calling fundraising. [See terms and condition here>](https://termsandconditionssample.com/)

1. You must be a Registered Fundraiser in order to conduct a third-party fundraising activity as part of united federation of volunteers for refugee’s action Australia Calling. This is required by charitable fundraising legislation in all States and Territories in Australia.

1. Registrations can be made via online enquire form, post **Reply Paid 99 Ness Road qld 4107**, online at <http://www.ufvra.org.au/> or <http://www.ufvra.org.au/> or by email to <http://www.ufvra.org.au/>
2. [www.ufvra.org.au](http://www.ufvra.org.au/) is owned and operated by united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia and <http://www.ufvra.org.au/> is owned and operated by a third party. (Together these sites are the "Event Websites").
3. United federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia manages united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia Calling on behalf of all state-based united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia offices and branches.
4. United federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia will not accept registrations from people residing in a country outside of Australia.
5. People residing outside Australia can make online donations or sponsor a friend in Australia who is taking part in united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia Calling. All donations will be accepted if in collaboration with supporting a united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia Calling fundraising event or activity.
6. If during your participation in united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia Calling as a Fundraiser or a Supporter united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia collects your personal information, united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia will send you information about how united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia collects and uses your personal information and your privacy rights. 7. united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia may incorporate Apps into its fundraising platform that allow Registered Fundraisers and Supporters to upload photographs which they can then elect to share on their social media pages. If you do not wish to use this function (if it is available) you should not upload any images if requested to do so by the fundraising platform.
8. The person whose name appears on the registration form will be the Registered Fundraiser which makes them solely accountable for managing the Event or Collection in an appropriate and responsible way. This includes cash handling and deciding on the Event date, venue, fundraising activity and any associated costs in running the Event.
9. United federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia will provide Registered Fundraisers with a Fundraiser Welcome Kit upon successful completion of a registration form being received. This will include but not limited to: a letter of authority to fundraise and equipment as requested on the registration form. Registered Fundraisers conducting a Collection will also receive a Volunteer ID badge, one receipt booklet and one plastic collection bag, secure collection buckets and lids.
10. Registered Fundraisers conducting a Collection for their united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia Calling activity must clearly wear their supplied Volunteer ID badge and carry their letter of authority to fundraise at all times. Volunteer ID badges must state the name of the Collector and be signed by that person.

11. All Volunteer ID badges are valid from Thursday, 1<sup>st</sup> to Saturday, 31<sup>st</sup> March 2018 and Collectors are not authorised to collect on behalf of Red Cross before or after these dates.
12. Fundraisers are not authorised to fundraise for united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia Calling until they receive their letter of authority to fundraise and Volunteer ID badge (where applicable). For enquiries relating to the registration process, please call 1800 733 276 between 8am-8pm AEDST (Monday to Friday) and 9am to 5pm AEDST (Saturday and Sunday).
13. All donations over \$2 are potentially tax deductible. Collectors may use the receipt booklet to issue a pre-printed or hand-written tax receipt to a Supporter if requested. Only one tax receipt is valid per Supporter.
14. Registered Fundraisers must only run Events or Collections during united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia Calling Month (1 to 31 March 2018).
15. Registered Fundraisers, agree to pay all costs involved with running their Event or Collection. Event costs are at the discretion of the Registered Fundraiser. United federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia will not reimburse any person/s for any Event or Collection associated costs.
16. If conducting door to door or public coin collections, Collectors must adhere to the fundraising legislation that applies to their State or Territory:

**VIC:** Door to door collections can be run in most council areas seven (7) days per week from Friday, 9<sup>th</sup> March 2018 to Sunday, 25<sup>th</sup> March 2018 between 9am and 6pm. Street collections can be run seven (7) days per week from Thursday, 1<sup>st</sup> March 2018 and Saturday, 31<sup>st</sup> March 2018 between 9am and 6pm. Some restrictions including exemption of collections on Sundays and Public Holidays apply in certain areas. Collectors will be advised by united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia if there is a restriction in the area in which they intend to collect. Intersection collections require approval from the local council and QLD Police. If you would like to conduct an intersection collection or a public coin collection please contact the united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia Calling team on 1800 733 276 to organise a permit.

**SA:** Door to door and street collections can be run seven (7) days per week from Friday, 9<sup>th</sup> March 2018 to Sunday, 25<sup>th</sup> March 2018 between the following times:

- 9am and 6pm on weekdays (Monday to Friday) for residential premises. 7am and 6pm for public locations
- 9am and 5pm on Saturdays for residential premises and public locations
- 11am and 5pm on Sundays for residential premises and public locations
- 11am and 5pm on Public Holidays (other than Good Friday and Easter Sunday) for residential premises and public locations

Some further restrictions may apply in particular Council areas. Collectors will be advised by united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia if there is a restriction in the area in which they intend to collect. If you would like to conduct a public coin collection please contact the united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia Calling team on 1800 733 276 to organise a permit.

**QLD:** Door to door and street collections can be run seven (7) days per week from Saturday, 10<sup>th</sup> March 2018 to Saturday, 24<sup>th</sup> March 2018 between 9am and 5pm.

**WA:** Door to door collections can be run seven (7) days per week from Friday, 9<sup>th</sup> March 2018 and Sunday, 25<sup>th</sup> March 2018 between 9am and 6pm. Street collections can be run seven (7) days per week from Thursday, 1<sup>st</sup> March 2018 and Saturday, 31<sup>st</sup> March 2018 between 9am and 6pm. Excludes:

- Monday, 12<sup>th</sup> March 2018
- Sunday, 25<sup>th</sup> March 2018

**QLD, NSW, ACT, TAS & NT:** Door to door collections can be run seven (7) days per week from Friday, 9<sup>th</sup> March 2018 and Sunday, 25<sup>th</sup> March 2018 between 9am and 6pm. Street collections can be run seven (7) days per week from Thursday, 1<sup>st</sup> March 2018 and Saturday, 31<sup>st</sup> March 2018 between 9am and 6pm.

18. United federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia will organise permits on the behalf of the Registered Fundraiser for all registered Collections including door to door, intersection, train station, shopping centre and other public coin collections. Permits are arranged using the completed details on the registration form.

19. If doorknocking in NSW, ACT, TAS and NT, no permits are required.

20. If doorknocking in QLD, state-wide permission has been obtained from the QLD Government Office of Fair Trading.

21. If doorknocking in WA, state-wide permission has been obtained from the WA Government Department of Commerce.

22. Collectors will be issued with designated areas for their fundraising and restrictions will vary:

- a.) If doorknocking, you are only permitted to Collect in the streets and/or suburbs assigned to you by united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia;
- b.) If conducting a public coin collection, you are only permitted to collect in the streets, suburbs and/or locations that you have a valid permit for which has been obtained by united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia.

23. Registered Fundraisers need to comply with any obligations in the Charitable Fundraising Act and/or any regulations in your State or Territory. You may be responsible for organising permits, licenses, insurance or authority to fundraise where necessary for fundraising activities such as raffles or competitions (this excludes permits for door to door and public coin collections which are organised by united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia at the point of registration). This information will be available from your state government or local council and obtaining these permits is the responsibility of the Fundraiser and not united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia. For all gaming, trading, racing, licensing, promotional and fundraising requirements, please check legislation by contacting your nearest office:

24. United federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia accepts no responsibility for any loss, liability or injury, occupational, health, safety and welfare claims arising from any Event or Collection. It is the responsibility of the Registered Fundraiser to ensure the safety of themselves and any attendees of their Event, including and providing first aid services if they are needed. Registered Fundraisers are responsible for obtaining and maintaining any appropriate insurance for their Event, including public liability insurance.

25. If conducting door to door or public coin collections, there are some standard safety requirements Collectors must adhere to:

- If a property is signed, 'beware of the dog', or if there is a dog that you are unsure of – do not enter the property
- Please wear sensible, non-slip, flat, enclosed shoes
- Please check the weather forecast before the start of your Collection. If there is a severe weather warning or high temperatures predicted for that day, please consider rescheduling to a different day
- Please ensure you dress appropriately for the weather and always use 30+ sunscreen. Take adequate water supply with you and have regular breaks



- If you are younger than 15 years of age, you must be accompanied by an adult
- united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia recommends working in pairs where possible. The likelihood of an incident is generally reduced if there is a second person to call for help. It is also good practice to let someone know where you are going and when you are likely to return. Where possible carry a fully charged mobile phone and in the case of an emergency, please ring 000
- Please decline any invitation to enter a house. Wait politely on the front doorstep
- united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia is a child safe organisation and therefore has a Child Protection Policy, in respect of persons who have contact with children in the course of their work for united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia. This includes all registered volunteers for united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia Calling. The hotline is open from 8am-8pm AEDST (Monday to Friday) and 9am to 5pm AEDST (Saturday and Sunday)

26. United federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia is a child safe organisation and therefore has a child protection code <http://www.ufvra.org.au/files/Child%20protection%20policy%20%20finally.pdf> in respect of persons who have contact with children in the course of their work for united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia. This includes all registered volunteers for united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia Calling. It is therefore a mandatory requirement that before you start fundraising, you have read and agreed to united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia' Child Protection Code of Conduct. 27. Organisations including community groups and schools registered to fundraise for united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia Calling are responsible for the safety and welfare of all children under the age of 18 years who are fundraising with that school or community group on behalf of united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia. Those organisations must ensure that they provide the children with appropriate safety guidelines and make them aware of the safety requirements set out in these Terms and Conditions.

28. United federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia' public liability insurance covers Registered Fundraisers who are conducting a Collection on behalf of united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia. It does not cover Registered Fundraisers who are running events of their own. We are not liable for assessing or managing any risks of fundraising Events or Collections run by external parties.

29. The Registered Fundraiser must securely keep all the money raised by the Collection or Event. Full records of the amount raised, along with the money, need to be securely deposited into the united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia bank account within 28 days after the Event or Collection taking place. All monies raised for united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia Calling must be returned to united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia by **Monday, 30th April 2018**.

30. If running a collection, Collectors are required to return all receipt booklets whether they have been used or not within 28 days after the completion of their activity. The receipted dollar value must not exceed the funds raised. If a receipt booklet is lost or stolen, a Statutory Declaration must be completed stating this and returned with payment in place of the receipt book. It is a criminal offence to write false tax receipts, and/or make a false declaration. All receipt booklets for united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia Calling must be returned to united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia by **Monday, 30th April 2018**. 31. You are not permitted to make telephone call collections as part of a united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia Calling fundraising Event or Collection.

32. If you are under 15 years of age, you must have the express permission of a parent or guardian before undertaking any fundraising activities as part of united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia Calling.

33. If you, as the Registered Fundraiser, have any previous criminal convictions, you need to tell us about them when you register. Although any prior convictions won't automatically prevent you from being able to organise an activity for us, they will be taken into account where relevant, for the purposes of assessing the suitability of the Event or Collection and yourself as the Registered Fundraiser. Failure to notify us of any previous criminal convictions may result in further investigation towards yourself and your fundraising activity or refusal for authority to fundraise on united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia' behalf.

34. You agree to release united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia to the fullest extent permissible under law for all claims and demands of any kind associated with the activity, and indemnify united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia for all liability or costs that may arise in respect to any damage, loss or injury occurring to any person in any way associated with the activity caused by your breach of these responsibilities or negligence.

35. If there is a likelihood of you not meeting any of these responsibilities, we reserve the right to withdraw your authority to organise an activity at any time.

36. We may amend these Terms and Conditions at any time during the campaign period. Upon amending Terms and Conditions we will re-post them at [www.ufvrcalling.org.au](http://www.ufvrcalling.org.au) and <https://fundraise.ufvra.org.au/>. Fundraisers will



be bound by the amended Terms and Conditions from that time. Any changes to the Promotion and/or Terms and Conditions relating to the united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia Calling promotion (including prize variations, cancellation or suspension of your promotion), is subject to the approval of all relevant State and Territory Departments.

37. Upon entering <http://www.ufvra.org.au/> or <https://fundraise.ufvra.org.au/> you have accepted and must comply with the Terms and Conditions, notices, disclaimers and intellectual property requirements on the Event Website/s. Your use of and/or continued access to the Event Website/s constitutes your agreement to the Terms and Conditions.

38. The Event Websites are run by united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia for this event only. Content may change but both sites will remain dedicated for united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia calling fundraising only.

39. Registered Fundraisers acknowledge and agree that the united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia emblem – a united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia on a white background – is a symbol of protection (protective use) and of membership of the International united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia and ufvra Crescent Movement (indicative use). In times of armed conflict it is the visible sign of the protection conferred by the Geneva Conventions on the victims and on those who come to their aid; in peacetime it shows that a person or object is linked to the International united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia and UFVRA Crescent Movement, of which the International Committee of the united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia (ufvra) is the founding body. The emblem is also a symbol of the Movement's seven Fundamental Principles: humanity, impartiality, neutrality, independence, voluntary service, unity and universality.

Registered Fundraisers or Supporters must not use the united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia logo or united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia emblem to advertise or conduct the Event or Collection except in accordance with the materials (if any) provided to you by united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia. **Unauthorised use of the united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia emblem may constitute a criminal offence under the Geneva Conventions Act 1957.** You must not do anything which might bring United federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia, the. United federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia emblem, or the united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia Or UFVRA Crescent movement into disrepute, or which might tarnish the prestige or reduce respect for the united federation of volunteers for refugee's action Australia emblem.
